

# DIY PROJECT GUIDE



## Gravestone Candy Box

Estimated project cost \$16  
(not including tools or paint)

### MATERIALS

- 1 – 2' x 2' x 1/2" Plywood
- 1 – Bag of Bones

### TOOLS USED

- Circular Saw
- Jig Saw
- 1 1/2" Brad Nails
- Measuring Tape
- Carpenter's Square
- Clamps
- Pencil
- Safety Goggles
- Sanding Block



### MEASURE AND MARK

Using the measuring tape, measure and mark cutouts on the 2' x 2' plywood according to the cut list.

To get a rounded shape on the top of the gravestone come down from the top 10" and draw a 10" arc. Tap a nail into the center of the gravestone 10" down and tie a string from the nail to the pencil to make a makeshift compass.



### CUT

Use a circular saw to make the long straight cuts on the plywood and a jigsaw for the curved cuts.

**TIP:** Use sanding block to smooth any rough edges.



### PAINT OR STAIN (OPTIONAL)

Paint or stain all cut pieces prior to assembly.



### ATTACH BOX SIDES

Hold the box sides up against the box front so that the edges are flush. Attach with nailer. Repeat on opposite side of box front.

Stand box front up and place sides so that they are between the gravestone back and the front. Secure with nailer through the back of the gravestone.



### ATTACH BOX BOTTOM

Place box bottom in between all other sides and press so that it is flush. Secure with nailer.



### ATTACH BAG OF BONES (OPTIONAL)

Place the bag of bones onto the gravestone candy box as desired.
